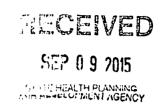

- 1. The financial scope of the project to include the preliminary estimate of costs broken down by equipment, construction, and yearly operating cost.
  - a. The ASC has seen consistent financial losses since inception. The facility had current liabilities with vendors as well as long term debt related to equipment it could not service. A third party appraiser determined the value of the ASC to be negligible. The selling parties were paid a total of \$10.00 for their equity. In addition to the purchase price the purchaser paid off all outstanding debts as well as renegotiated the building lease to remove all previous owners from the lease liability.
- 2. The services to be offered by the proposal (the applicant will state whether he has previously offered the service and whether the service is an extension of a presented offered service, or whether the service is a new service)
  - a. There will be no change in the services currently being provided at the ASC.
- 3. Whether the proposal will include the addition of any new beds.
  - a. There will be no addition of beds, operating rooms or procedure rooms to the existing ASC.

  - a. Brookwood Medical Center has been a 20% owner in the ASC since inception. This transaction is simply Brookwood purchasing the stock from all other partners to make this a 100% Brookwood owned entity.
