Re: Project Modification Request for USA Mobile County ASC, LLC (Project AL2022-028, CON 3018-ASC)

Dear Ms. Marsal:

On behalf of USA Mobile County ASC, LLC (“USA ASC”), I am submitting this Request for Project Modification for the above referenced CON Project, filed in accordance with Ala. Admin. Code § 410-1-10-.03 with the State Health Planning and Development Agency (“SHPDA”) and requesting the relocation of the project within Mobile County.

The original USA ASC certificate of need (“CON”) included the following location for the USA ASC facility, USA Health Blvd, Mobile, Alabama 36608, which is the USA Health West Mobile Campus including a FED and physician office building in west Mobile. Following receipt of the CON, USA Health acquired Providence Hospital, also located in west Mobile, at 6801 Airport Boulevard, Mobile, AL 36608. Accordingly, after much analysis and review by USA Health, it has been determined that relocating the USA ASC to a professional office building located on the USA Health Providence Hospital campus at 6701 Airport Blvd, Building A101, 1st Floor, Mobile, AL 36608, is desirable and in the best interest of its patient care objectives.

The number of operating rooms and procedure rooms are not changing with the proposed relocation and will continue to include six (6) operating rooms and two (2) procedure rooms in west Mobile, Mobile County. Attached as **Exhibit A** is a schematic for the proposed new location which will be located within a multi-tenant professional office building on the first floor.

This proposed new location is only 0.82 linear miles from the original approved USA ASC project site. Attached hereto as **Exhibit B** are a USA Health Providence Hospital campus map reflecting the proposed new location as well as a map reflecting the distance between the two locations (i.e., CON approved location versus requested new location). The original USA ASC CON project was a freestanding ASC in a new construction building and the proposed new location will be located within a multi-tenant professional office building where several of the surgeons anticipated to use the USA ASC facility have their physician practice offices. Also, the new site for the USA ASC facility in the on-campus professional office building is connected to USA Health Providence Hospital by two enclosed walkways. Proximity to additional health care resources is a positive of the proposed new USA ASC location that will enhance efficiencies through easy access by surgeons as well as some USA Health resource economies of scale.

Accordingly, USA ASC is respectfully requesting a modification to its CON to relocate the USA ASC to the first floor of USA Health Providence Hospital's on-campus professional office building at 6701 Airport Blvd, Building A101, 1st Floor, Mobile, AL 36608. USA ASC believes that it is in the best interest of the area patient population to allow for this relocation of the USA ASC as described herein.

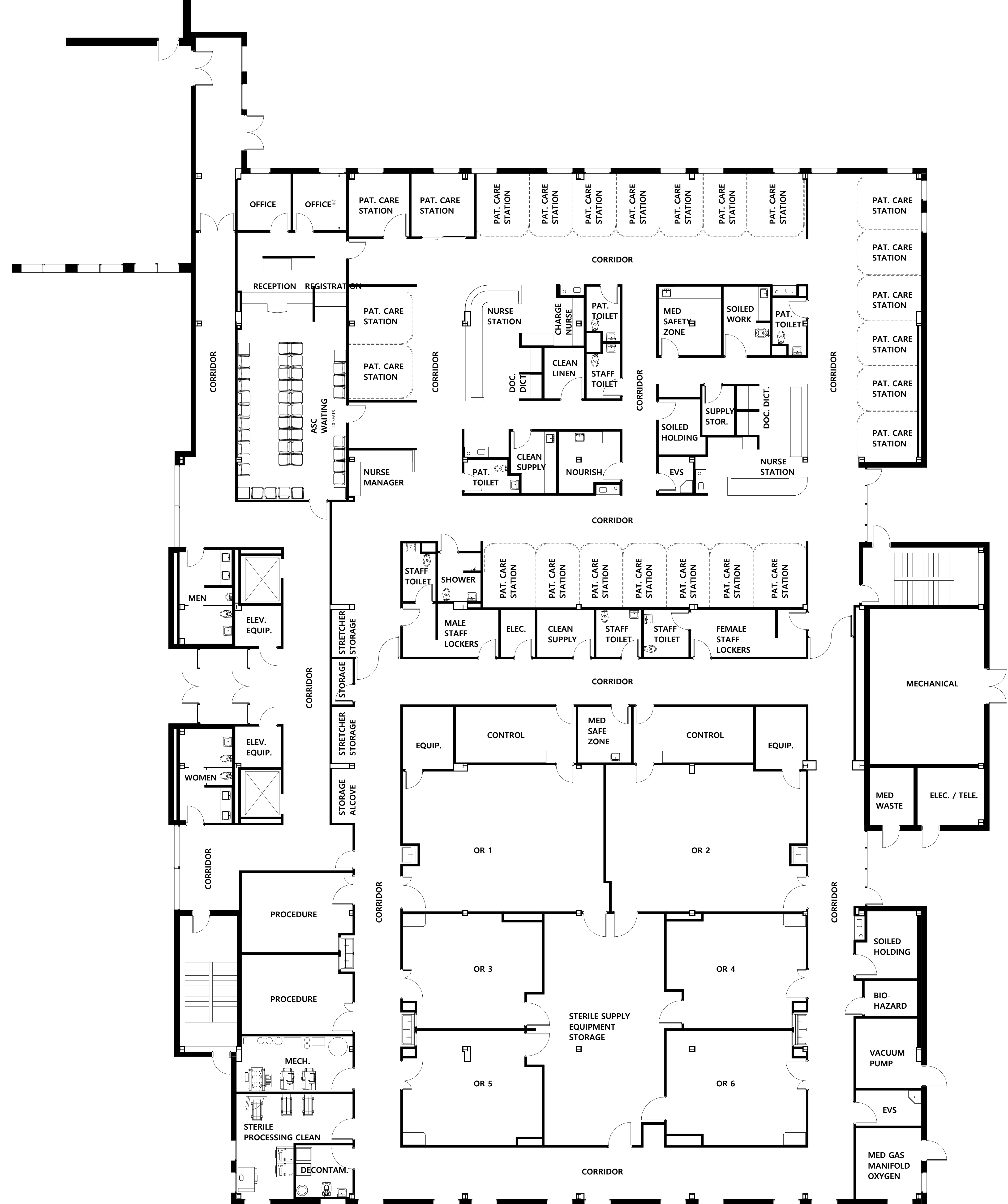
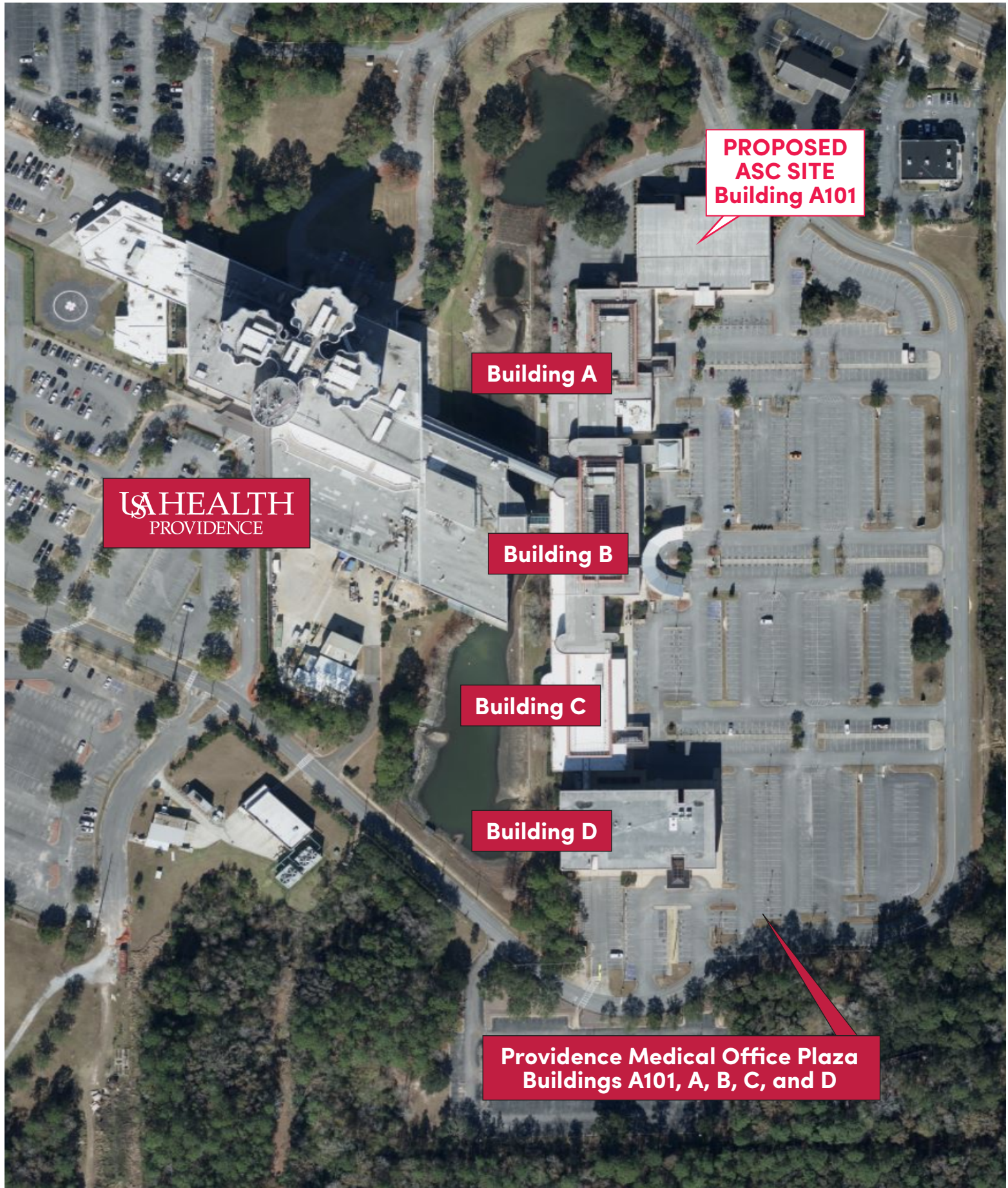
