This conversion is necessary as demonstrated during the pandemic of 2020, and the shortage of isolation rooms we experienced at Dale Medical Center. The conversion of these rooms will equip Dale Medical Center to better meet the needs of any future influx of patients needing to be isolated. Please note that the conversion of these rooms will not change our current bed capacity, will not be introducing a new service, and the cost will not exceed the threshold established by SHPDA. The project simply involves installation of barriers between the rooms and mechanical upgrades to create the required negative airflow. The anticipated cost of the project is approximately \$479,000. It is our belief that the project is not reviewable for purpose of CON. Please advise.
