Dear Mrs. Marsal:

Surgical Clinic Solutions, LLC, d.b.a. Surgical Institute of Alabama ("SIA") is a multi-specialty ambulatory surgery center ("ASC") operating in Jefferson County seeking your determination that SIA is not required to obtain a Certificate of Need for the proposed addition of two (2) operating rooms at its existing ASC. We are providing the following information to assist with this determination.

SIA provides surgical services in Vestavia Hills, Alabama. The full scope of surgical services provided by the multi-specialty ASC includes: Spine Surgery, Orthopedic Surgery, General Surgery, Urological Surgery, Ophthalmological Surgery and Pain Management Procedures. No new services will be offered as a result of this project.

SIA is owned by 18 of its active medical staff members. No other healthcare facilities, entities or groups hold any financial interests in SIA.

The proposed project would include the addition of two (2) operating rooms and storage space on the campus of SIA. The proposed project would allow SIA to meet the current and anticipated future needs for surgical services within the existing ASC. Currently, due to the acuity level of most surgeries performed at SIA taking precedence over other surgeries, patients are having to be displaced and care delayed due to available operating time at SIA. This project will offer additional opportunities to provide surgical services to patients of Jefferson County and surrounding communities as well as benefiting the clinicians of SIA with better & more timely ease of access to surgical services.

The estimated costs to be incurred by SIA for the proposed project are as follows:

The estimated equipment costs for the proposed project include all standard surgical equipment to fully equip the two (2) operating rooms, also including specialized equipment required for Spine and Orthopedic procedures, additional patient stretchers, appropriate shelving within storage areas and technological equipment.

Accordingly, the proposed project will not exceed any of the CON expenditure thresholds specified in CON Rule 410-1-2-.07—that is: \$3,241,543.00 for major medical equipment, \$1,296,615.00 for new annual operating costs, or \$6,483,085.00 for total capital expenditures, as currently adjusted for CPI.

The new capital cost estimate includes an additional lease cost that SIA will incur to occupy the space for the project. The building owners will assume financial responsibility for all construction costs. SIA will not incur any construction costs for the project.

Accordingly, the proposal does not constitute a "new institutional health service" subject to CON review under Ala. Code 22-21-263 and CON Rule 410-1-4-.01 because the proposal does not include any of the following:

- 1. The construction, development, acquisition through lease or purchase or other establishment of a healthcare facility or health maintenance organization;
- 2. Any expenditure by or on behalf of a health care facility or health maintenance organization exceeding the CON statutory thresholds for major medical equipment, new annual operating costs, or any other capital expenditure by or on behalf of a health care facility;
- 3. The addition of any inpatient beds or conversion of one classification of beds into another classification of beds;
- 4. Any health service which is proposed to be offered in or through a health care facility which was not offered on a regular basis in or through such health care facility within the preceding twelvementh period;
- 5. Any relocation of a health care facility; or
- 6. Any other reviewable activity under existing CON statutes or regulations of the State of Alabama.

We respectfully request SHPDA's determination that the proposal described in this letter is not subject to CON review. The required filing fee of \$1,000 will be submitted in accordance with SHPDA Rule 410-3-09, electronic filing. Please contact me directly if any additional requests for information are needed to complete your review of this Reviewability Determination Request.


