Re: Reviewability Request Hale County Hospital Emergency Department Renovation

Dear Ms. Marsal,

The Hale County Health Care Authority (the "Authority") owns and operates Hale County Hospital (the "Hospital") in Greensboro, Hale County, AL. With this letter, we request, on behalf of the Authority, written confirmation that the Hospital is not subject to Certificate of Need review prior to renovating the existing Hospital Emergency Department. Please see the attached report (generated on May 9, 2024, by the Rural Health Information Hub, which is funded by the Federal Office of Rural Health Policy) that confirms the Hospital is classified as Rural by the federal government. Hale County Hospital currently operates an emergency department on its main hospital campus. The hospital's current emergency department presents patient throughput and efficiency challenges in the current treatment space. To improve patient throughput in the existing emergency department, Hale County Hospital plans to build-out existing shell space already enclosed in the current emergency department footprint to accommodate two (2) additional dedicated and enclosed emergency department treatment rooms, renovate waiting and reception areas, and nursing station.

- No other health care facility has a financial interest in the proposed project.

The proposed construction will not exceed any of the CON expenditure thresholds set forth in Section 410-1-2-.07 of the CON rules, which effective October 1, 2023 are \$3,322,582 for major medical equipment, \$1,327,734 for new annual operating cost, and \$6,638,679 for other capital expenditures.

This proposed renovation in the emergency department will result in neither an increase in the number of licensed inpatient beds nor a reclassification of beds. Further, the renovation will not result in the implementation of a new institutional health service or change the Hospital's existing service area.

For these reasons, the proposed renovation is not subject to CON review. See Ala. Code 1975, 22-21-263; CON Rules 410-1-2.07. We therefore respectfully request your determination that Hale County Hospital is not required to obtain a CON in order to undertake the renovation described in this letter. We appreciate your consideration of this request, and we welcome the opportunity to address any questions regarding this matter.

FACTUAL INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR REVIEWABILITY DETERMINATION REQUESTS (SHPDA Rule 410-1-7-.02)

Any person may request for informational purposes only a determination as to the current reviewability of an anticipated project or determination of exemption for replacement equipment. Such request shall be submitted pursuant to the electronic filing requirements of SHPDA Rule 410-1-3-.09, disclosing full factual information, as more specifically identified below, and supplemented by any additional information or documentation which the Executive Director may deem necessary. SHPDA Rule 410-1-7-.02(1).

The following information must be included in all requests for reviewability determinations other than requests made pursuant to the Physician's Office Exemption (POE) or regarding End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) stations, which must provide unique information specific to those providers:

- 1. Name of company seeking the reviewability determination.
- 2. Address and contact information for the authorized company representative seeking the determination.
- 3. Service area for the proposed service/equipment.
- 4. Any new/additional services to be provided under the proposed project.
- 5. Approximated costs of the proposed project for:
 - a. Equipment
 - b. First year annual operating costs
 - c. Capital costs, to include:
 - i. Leases
 - ii. Land/Building costs
 - iii. Construction costs
- 6. Disclosure of financial interests in the entity requesting the reviewability determination held by any other healthcare facilities or groups.
- 7. Attestation by an officer, partner or authorized agent of the company having knowledge of the facts disclosed in the reviewability request, utilizing the following form:

Each determination must be accompanied by a \$1,000 filing fee submitted in accordance with SHPDA Rule 410-1-3-.09, <u>Electronic Filing</u>. Once deemed complete, notice of the request shall be published on the Agency's website for thirty (30) business days, and additional notice of the request shall be provided to the general distribution list maintained by the Agency. Any affected person may file comments with the Agency pursuant to SHPDA Rule 410-1-3-.09 regarding the issuance of the requested letter of non-reviewability. The Executive Director may provide a response to the request within forty-five (45) days of the request, unless additional time is needed to obtain additional information or to evaluate comments filed in opposition of the request.


