**CONTESTED CASE/RECONSIDERATION**

**A. AL2018-005 Bay Eyes Surgery Center, Inc., Fair Hope, AL:**

Proposes to add one (1) Class-C operating room to the existing two (2) Class-C operating rooms, convert space to a Class-C OR for a total of four (4) Class-C OR's and change the current designation as a single-specialty ambulatory surgery center to a multi-specialty ASC. This project was heard by Administrative Law Judge Mike Cole in a Contested Case Hearing on August 11, 2020. The ALJ finds and recommends to the CON Review Board that the Request for Reconsideration of CON-2836-ASC be denied and the suspension of CON-2836-ASC be lifted.

**B. AL2020-018, Bio-Medical Applications of Alabama, Inc. d/b/a Fresenius Medical Care Foley, Foley, AL:** Expand the existing sixteen (16) station End State Renal Disease (ESRD) Treatment Center through the addition of six (6) in-center hemodialysis stations, for a total of twenty-two (22) stations, one (1) of which is an isolation station, pursuant to Rule 410-2-3-.05(1)(c). **Opposition: None**

**C. AL2020-019, St. Vincent's Birmingham, Birmingham, AL:** Add two (2) cardiac catheterization labs to the existing four (4) cardiac catheterization labs for a total of six (6) cardiac catheterization labs. **Opposition: None**

- D. **AL2020-022, Legendary Living Services VR, LLC d/b/a Legendary Living Montgomery Specialty Care Assisted Living, Montgomery, AL:** Establish a new twenty-four (24) bed specialty care assisted living facility (SCALF) as part of a senior living community pursuant to a Plan Adjustment approved by Governor Ivey on September 23, 2019. **Opposition: None**
- E. **AL2020-023, Carillon Oaks Lincoln, LLC, Lincoln, AL:** Construct and operate a forty-three (43) bed specialty care assisted living facility (SCALF) within a campus consisting of ALF and SCALF units. **Opposition: None**
- F. **AL2020-024, EAMC - Lanier, Valley, AL:** Convert twenty (20) general acute care inpatient beds to twenty (20) inpatient geriatric psychiatric beds pursuant to a Plan Adjustment approved by Governor Ivey on September 23, 2019. **Opposition: None**
- G. **AL2020-025, USA Health University Hospital, Mobile, AL:** Renovate the 4th floor to convert six (6) existing rooms into isolation rooms for patients with infectious diseases and renovate the outdated facilities on the 10th and 11th floors to offer four (4) additional isolation rooms. **Opposition: None**
- H. **AL2020-026, St. Vincent's East, Birmingham, AL:** Add one (1) cardiac catheterization lab to the existing three (3) cardiac catheterization labs for a total of four (4) cardiac catheterization labs. **Opposition: None**
- I. **AL2020-043-E, Gulf Health Hospitals, Inc. d/b/a Thomas Hospital:** Expand by adding fourteen (14) additional acute care beds by the end of 2020 (Phase I) and add sixteen (16) additional acute care beds in 2021 (Phase II).
