- A. **AL2026-023, Rehabilitation Hospital of Phenix City, Russell County, AL:** Proposes to add ten (10) additional inpatient physical rehabilitation beds to their current fifty-eight (58) existing beds for a total of sixty-eight (68) inpatient physical rehabilitation beds at the existing rehabilitation hospital in Phenix City, Russell County, Alabama, Inpatient Rehabilitation Region V in accordance with the Bed Availability Assurance Rule in the Inpatient Rehabilitation section of the 2024-2027 *Alabama State Health Plan*. **Opposition: None**
- B. **AL2026-024, Encompass Health Rehabilitation Hospital of Gadsden, LLC d/b/a Encompass Health Rehabilitation Hospital of Gadsden, Etowah County, AL:** Proposes to add ten (10) additional inpatient physical rehabilitation beds to their current fifty-four (54) existing beds for a total of sixty-four (64) inpatient physical rehabilitation beds at the existing rehabilitation hospital in Gadsden, Etowah County, Alabama, Inpatient Rehabilitation Region IV in accordance with the Bed Availability Assurance Rule in the Inpatient Rehabilitation section of the 2024-2027 *Alabama State Health Plan*. **Opposition: None**
- C. **AL2026-025, East Alabama Medical Center, Lee County, AL:** Proposes to expand and renovate the Spencer Cancer Center, an existing facility located in the city of Opelika, Lee County, Alabama. Upon completion, the newly renovated center will have 30,500 additional square feet for clinical space pertaining to patient care and physician offices, which includes a gynecological oncology and breast surgery suite, increased capacity in imaging, pharmacy, and laboratory

services, as well as a second PET/CT scanner. It is noted this project does not include the addition of a third linear accelerator. **Opposition: None**
